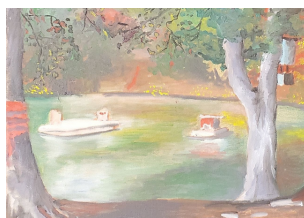
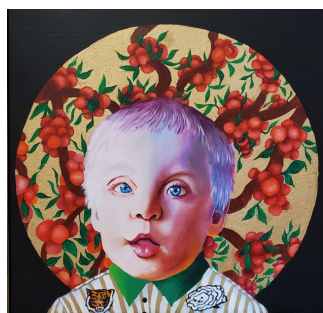
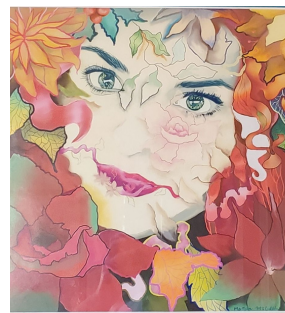
*Morgan
