## Library Cards and Collections for Minors

The Jackson Parish Library splits children's cards into two different categories: Juvenile for ages 5-11 and Young Adult for ages 12-17. Our books are broken up into 3 categories: Juvenile which are intended for children ages 0-11, Young Adult which are intended for children ages 12-17, and Adult which is intended for patrons 18 and older. All material that has been declared as sexually explicit pursuant to LA R.S 25:225 will be categorized as Adult.

Parents have the choice to allow their children unrestricted access to check out any book in the library. An updated library card application with parent's signature is required to be on file in the child's account.

Juvenile cards can check out Juvenile books.

Young Adult cards can check out Juvenile and Young Adult books.

Adult cards and Unrestricted Children's cards can check out any book no matter the classification.

Pursuant to library policy, children are not able to check out DVD's, Blu-ray's, or hotspots.

## Online Resources and Internet Access

The Jackson Parish Library provides access to many online resources such as e-books and databases.

Parents have the ability to block all electronic content that verify identity through our integrated library system.

Children under the age of eighteen (18) must have permission from a parent/legal guardian as indicated on their library card registration form and library record in order to access the Internet on the library's computers. Please note that using library computers will allow access to all online resources as the computers are not tied to a patrons account. However, internet access is filtered for all users to certain content which are obscene and/or harmful to minors pursuant to the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA).
